Application Fee:	This fee is non-refundable and must be submitted with the application form.
New family	\$150.00
Returning family	No application fee applies.
Registration Fee:	This fee must be submitted yearly to the school office with your child's registration or re-registration form. Your child's acceptance is not complete until we receive the fee and all required forms.
New family	Upon acceptance, a \$300.00 fee per child is required. This fee is non-refundable, but \$200.00 of this amount is applied to your child's tuition.
Returning family	\$300.00 per family, non-refundable, but all of this amount will be applied to the tuition.
Student Fee: New & Returning Families	\$450.00 will be added to the SMART tuition. This fee covers books, classroom instructional materials and supplies, technology needs and classroom party fees for any student in Grades K-8 only. Please note that all students do not receive the same materials, but on average, each grade level carries the same per student cost.
Laptop Fee:	\$150.00 per child, Grades 6-8 only, will be added to SMART tuition
Graduation Fee:	\$150.00 per child, Grade 8 only, will be added to SMART tuition
Tuition Assistance:	Limited tuition assistance is available through the Archdiocese of Washington (ADW). Families may also apply to the school for need-based tuition assistance.
New family	New families must apply by the February ADW deadline via an on-line link to TADS at www.mytads.com or by using the link found on our school website. (Limited paper applications are available.) All families who apply will be considered for in-house assistance.
Returning family	Returning families must apply by the December ADW deadline via an on-line link to TADS at www.mytads.com or by visiting the financial assistance link at www.adw.org . All families who apply will be considered for in-house assistance.

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SMART Tuition:	All families not paying in full by <u>August 10, 2018</u> must be enrolled in the SMART Tuition Management Program. The annual <u>\$50.00</u> Smart administrative fee is added to the tuition and collected with the first payment. The tuition and applicable fees may be paid in 10, 11, or 12 monthly installments or quarterly. The late payment/follow up fee is <u>\$65.00</u> .
New family	New families complete an on-line enrollment form at www.enrollwithsmart.com by <u>June 1, 2018</u> , or just as soon as notification of acceptance is received.
Returning family	Current families are automatically re-enrolled in their existing payment plan unless they request a change from SMART.
Fundraising/Volunteer Hours:	All new and returning families must meet a \$300.00 fundraising obligation per school year. This obligation is met easily through school fundraising programs. Each family must also meet a requirement of 15 volunteer hours per year or pay a buyout of \$10.00 for each unmet volunteer hour, hours should be recorded in the volunteer book in the school office
Extended Care:	All new and returning K-8 families may participate in our Extended Care Program which operates from 6:30AM until 6:00PM. Preschool children may also participate providing they are enrolled in any full day option. (Separate fee applies and every family participating must complete an enrollment form to satisfy Child Care Administration requirements.)
Uniforms:	Children in Grades K-8 are required to wear dress and PE uniforms. Both dress and PE uniforms may be purchased through Flynn & O'Hara School Uniforms. Dress uniforms only may also be purchased through Lands' End. (Please note that Lands' End also does not sell all items with the appropriate school plaid for girls, so please consult the handbook for further information if you choose to order from Lands' End.) Children in our Preschool Program should wear comfortable clothing with any closures (buttons, snaps, etc.) being easily manageable by your child.
After School Activities:	Varies year-to-year but includes: Archdiocesan Band, Choir, CYO Basketball Math Counts, Jr. High Bible Study, Math Counts, Piano, Scouting, St. Vincent de Paul Society, Scouting, Student Council and the Art, Drama, Homework and Robotics Clubs. (Separate fee applies to most, but not all, activities.)
Summer Session:	Students in Preschool - Grade 2 may attend our Summer Session which starts following the end of our regular school year. Our Summer Session runs for 10 weeks, each week having a different theme. Full day and half day sessions are available, as well as extended care. (Separate fee and registration form applies and children in attendance must have all required emergency and health forms on file.) An early registration discount, as well as a discount for attendance during the entire Summer Session is also available. Registration form on school website at www.mogschool.com .
